REQUIREMENTS:

Students will participate in the training dressed in protective clothing, (i.e., bee suit with attaching veil and helmet, bee gloves, work boots or protective ankle wraps), hive tool and smoker. The reading of the text is a must. Attendance for each session is important, since it is difficult to duplicate hive conditions for non-attendees at a future session.

TUITION for the entire course:

\$100 dollars per student, payable in advance, if you provide your own hive.

\$150 per student, payable in advance, if you don't provide a hive.

\$20 per session if you attend a single scheduled session.

Details of each session will be made available at the March 20th 2010 SEMBA Annual Bee Conference for students registering for the course. Fee includes a text and a one-year SEMBA membership, but does not include equipment.
